You can register on-line from May 1 to July 20 for the overall Junior Ranger Program. For scheduled events, online registration is separate & will be open 2 weeks prior to the event. Those registered for the overall program will receive an email link & reminder to notify you when event registration is open. Events take place Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Saturday mornings from July to mid-August.
