Here's how the selection process works:
The $4^{\text {th }}$ grade teachers reviewed bus lists and highlighted the name of any student that would make a good bus safety- those who are responsible, reliable, and assertive. They may have highlighted more than one student per bus depending on the students.

When the teachers finished, just about every bus had more than 2-3 students whose names were highlighted. For these busses, the names of the highlighted students will be put in a bowl and names will be drawn randomly. The students whose names are drawn will be offered the position of bus safety for that bus. The students whose names are not drawn for bus safety plus any prime time students who were nominated will be put in another drawing for hallway, carpool, and sign holder positions.

To be clear, there were more students nominated than there are available posts. There WILL be wonderful and responsible students who are not given a safety job. We wish there were enough spots for everyone but the spots are limited. There will be other opportunities in $5^{\text {th }}$ grade to participate and contribute so please don't be too upset. We thank you for understanding.
